

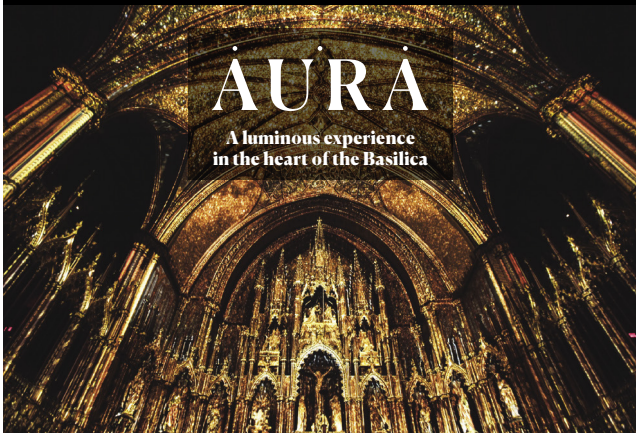

Get Lazy at the Clock Tower Beach

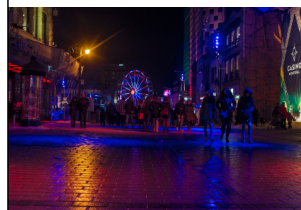
