### ▼ GEVA THEATRE CENTER

Rochester's leading professional, live theatre, with new monthly productions.  
*Distance from ROC: 1.1 miles*

## MUSEUMS

### STRONG MUSEUM OF PLAY

Interactive exhibits, including the world's largest collection of toys, dolls and games.  
*Distance from ROC: 1 mile*

### GEORGE EASTMAN MUSEUM

The world's oldest photography museum and one of the oldest film archives.  
*Distance from ROC: 1.9 miles*

## FOOD & DRINK

### BLACK BUTTON DISTILLING

Farm-distillery using all-natural ingredients sourced in New York State. Taste its small-batch whiskeys, gins, bourbons and Apple Pie moonshine.  
*Distance from ROC: 1.6 miles*

### GOOD LUCK

Homemade pastas, smokehouse dishes and vegetables reflecting the region. Named one of the Best Bars in America by *Esquire* in 2016.  
*Distance from ROC: 1.6 miles*

### ▼ SWAN MARKET

An authentic German deli. Eat a homemade brat with a beer at one of the lively communal tables, or take it home.  
*Distance from ROC: 2.2 miles*



## FAMILY FUN

### ▲ SENECA PARK ZOO

See amphibians, birds, fish, invertebrates, reptiles and mammals, including African elephants, lions and giraffes, at a 20-acre zoo dedicated to wildlife conservation.  
*Distance from ROC: 3.5 miles*

## SPORTS & OUTDOORS

### GENESSEE RIVERWAY TRAIL

Walk, hike or bike throughout the heart of Rochester on this scenic trail along the Genesee River.  
*Distance from ROC: 2.8 miles*

## HISTORY

### MOUNT HOPE CEMETERY

196-acre arboretum and Victorian cemetery with 350,000 graves. A veritable museum of funerary sculpture and mausoleums, and a peaceful place to stroll.  
*Distance from ROC: 3.3 miles*
