ARTS & CULTURE

STORM KING ARTS CENTER

Sculptures from WWII to contemporary works from over 100 Hudson Valley artists on a 500-acre landscape.
Distance from CRT: 25.3 miles

LUMBERYARD

A women-led performing arts center showcasing contemporary performances and artists-in-residence.
Distance from HUD: 6 miles

▼ BARDAVON 1869 OPERA HOUSE

Live performances by legendary artists, orchestras, dancers and comedians. 150 years old, the oldest continually operating theater in New York State.
Distance from POU: 0.5 mile



HISTORY

▼ HOME OF FRANKLIN DELANO ROOSEVELT

Home of the 32nd U.S. President. Tour FDR's presidential library, gardens, museum and personal retreat, Top Cottage.
Distance from POU: 4.7 miles



KYKUIT, ROCKEFELLER ESTATE

A meticulously maintained, historic landmark where four generations of Rockefeller's lived.
Distance from CRT: 8 miles

BOSCobel

Nineteenth-century, federal-style mansion containing one of the finest collections of décor and art from this era.
Distance from CRT: 17.9 miles

SPORTS & OUTDOORS

HUDSON VALLEY RAIL TRAIL

A four-mile, multi-use recreation trail that connects to Walkill Valley Rail Trail, River-to-Ridge Trail and Dutchess County Rail Trail via Walkway Over The Hudson.
Distance from POU: 0.2 mile

FOOD & DRINK

HENRY'S AT THE FARM

Where "local" is a mantra. New American cuisine made with local ingredients from the on-site farm.
Distance from POU: 5.4 miles

HELSINKI HUDSON

A former industrial complex transformed into a farm-to-table eatery with live music.
Distance from HUD: 0.7 mile

X20 XAVIER'S ON THE HUDSON

Chef Peter X. Kelly's acclaimed, glass-enclosed restaurant over the Hudson River, serving globally influenced American fare.
Distance from YNY: 0.1 mile

FAMILY FUN

▼ WALKWAY OVER THE HUDSON

A former rail bridge over the Hudson River, now the world's longest elevated pedestrian bridge (1.28 miles).
Distance from POU: 0.6 mile
