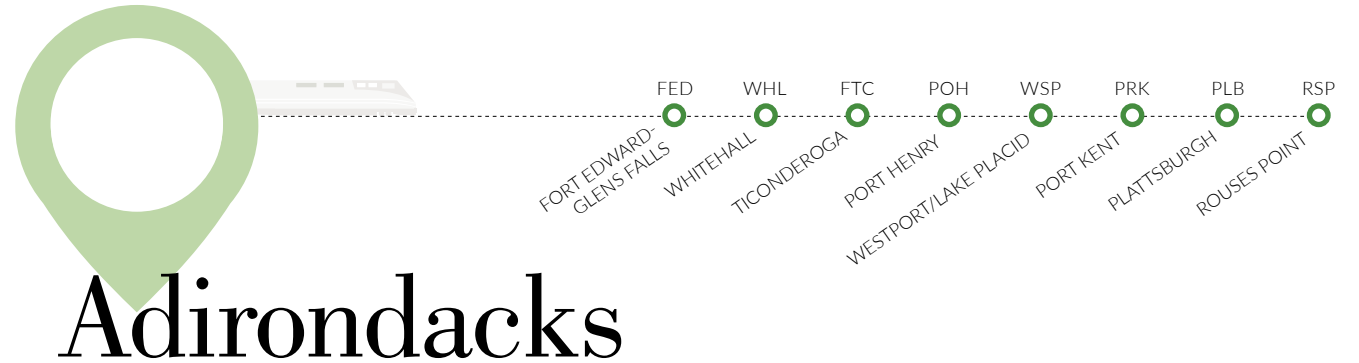

## FOOD & DRINK

▼ **MOHICAN FAMILY DINNER CRUISE**  
A 1.5-hour cruise on Lake George aboard the oldest, continuously operated steamship in the U.S, built in 1908.  
Distance from FED: 15.5 miles



**ADIRONDACK WINERY**  
Local, award-winning wines, with a view of Lake George and the Adirondack Mountains, at one of the first micro-wineries in the country.  
Distance from FED: 15.7 miles

**ELFS FARM WINERY & CIDER HOUSE**  
A family-owned producer of wine and hard cider. Listen to live music at "Friday Wine Down". Open mic during Sunday brunch with a build-your-own-Bloody Mary bar.  
Distance from PLB: 4 miles

## HISTORY

**FORT TICONDEROGA**  
Restored 18th century fort has diverse collections of military artifacts, weaponry, books and memorabilia.  
Distance from FTC: 1 mile

**CROWN POINT STATE HISTORIC SITE**  
Ruins from the colonial wars between the British and the French, Crown Point Pier and Champlain Memorial Lighthouse.  
Distance from POH: 7.1 miles

## ARTS & CULTURE

▼ **HYDE COLLECTION**  
One of the Northeast's most notable small art museums, including works by Botticelli, Rembrandt, Picasso and Renoir.  
Distance from FED: 5.4 miles



**DEPOT THEATER**  
Watch professional storytellers, dancers and singers in the historic Westport train station, built in 1876.  
Distance from WSP: 0 miles

**SPORTS & OUTDOORS**  
▼ **NATURAL STONE BRIDGE AND CAVES PARK**  
A family-owned, family-friendly cave system, with a natural stone bridge. Choose between a self-guided trail or spelunking with a guide.  
Distance from FTC: 32.3 miles



**LAKE PLACID OLYMPIC CENTER**  
Site of the 1980 "Miracle on Ice" USA-Russia Olympic hockey game, plus speed-skating and figure-skating. Watch competitions and shows or go skating, year-round.  
Distance from WSP: 34.7 miles

**SIX FLAGS GREAT ESCAPE**  
In Queensbury, kid-friendly amusement park, year-round indoor waterpark, interactive games, lodge and dining.  
Distance from FED: 10.4 miles
