Getting to Cooperstown

Take Amtrak from Penn Station **1** in NYC to the Albany-Rensselaer station.

2 Pick up an Enterprise rental car at the station.

3 Drive west on I-90, I-88, or on the Route 20 Scenic Byway.



FAMILY FUN

VERIE CANAL CRUISES Experience the Erie Canal on a yacht, with commentary about historic sites and wildlife. Distance from UCA: 14.3 miles



ADIRONDACK SCENIC RAILROAD Scenic train-ride between Utica and Lake Placid. Specials include Beer & Wine, Fall Foliage, Halloween and Haunted History trains. Distance from UCA: 0 miles

FOOD AND DRINK BREWERY OMMEGANG

Belgian-style craft brews, including HBO's Game of Thrones-inspired beer. Distance from UCA: 42.5 miles

HISTORY

FORT STANWIX NATIONAL MONUMENT

See reenactments at "the fort that never surrendered", located at a strategic colonial link between the Atlantic Ocean and Lake Ontario

Distance from ROM: 1 mile

VAMSTERDAM CASTLE Stay at this former armory and private

castle, built in 1877, now a luxurious boutique hotel. Distance from AMS: 2.3 miles

WARDER DEEKMAN 1802 MERCANTILE

SPORTS & OUTDOORS MOHAWK VALLEY GATEWAY OVERLOOK Pedestrian bridge and park over the Mohawk River connecting the Erie Canalway Trail to Riverlink Park and downtown Amsterdam. Distance from AMS: 2.5 miles

AMSTERDAM-PATTERSONVILLE TRAILWAY New 5-mile trail between Amsterdam and Pattersonville, the latest addition to the **Empire State Trail** Distance from AMS: 2.3 Miles
